Smilelign is a clear aligner treatment, available from your dentist, that gives you the smile you have always dreamed of.

Your dentist will share your treatment plan. This includes before and after images, how many aligners you will need, and expected treatment time.

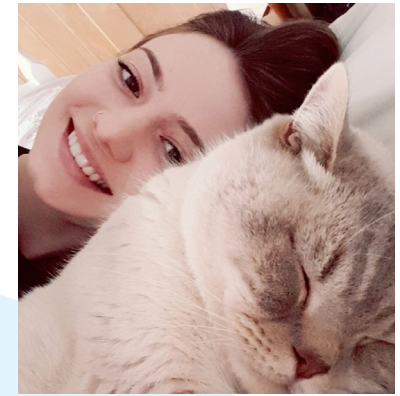
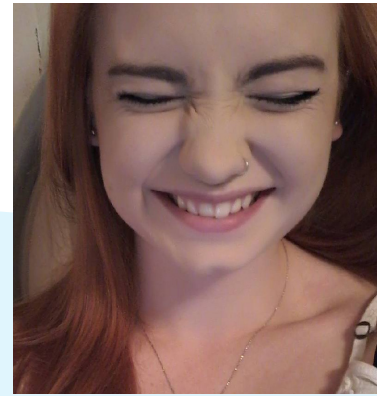

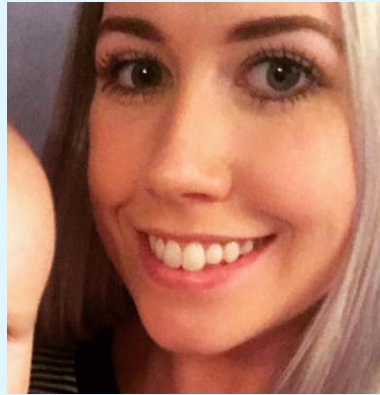

Patient Q&A

WHY SMILELIGN?

I'd been wanting braces for a long time as I was unhappy with my teeth. My friend told me about Smilelign aligners, so I looked on the website, looked at testimonials and I thought 'I'm going to do it'.

WHAT HAPPENED NEXT?

I booked a consultation with the dentist, where he looked at my teeth and said that Smilelign would be a good option.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

I had to visit my dentist every two weeks to get my aligners changed. My dentist would check that the aligner fitted correctly as sometimes when you go back for a checkup, your teeth aren't quite ready for the next aligner.

at the beginning when I first got the aligners, but after a couple of weeks they were fine.

HOW LONG WAS YOUR TREATMENT?

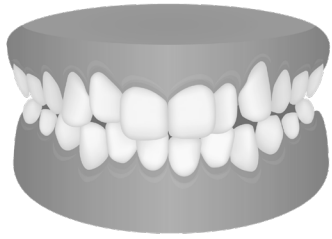
I started in April and finished in September, so it was six months in total. I was happy with this as my treatment plan said that it would be about six months.

HOW ARE THE RESULTS?

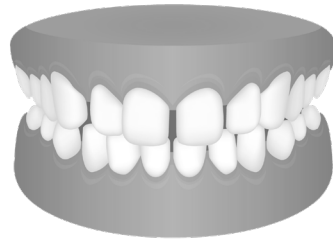
I'm really happy with the results and everybody comments on my teeth now! It has definitely made me feel more confident about myself and I do really like my teeth now.

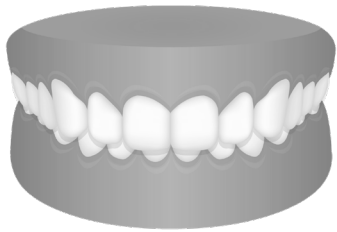




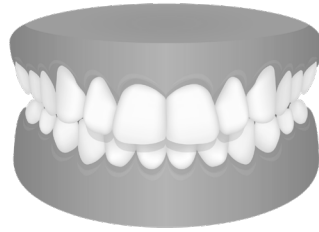

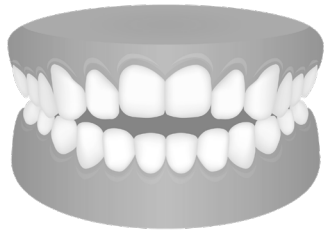

What can Smilealign aligners correct?

CROWDING

Crowding is commonly identified by the overlapping or twisting of teeth. If left untreated, it can make it difficult to clean and floss your teeth correctly. Smilealign can resolve issues with crowding, improving your dental care as a result.

SPACING

Spacing is identified by larger than average gaps between your teeth. This is most common between the front teeth. This can lead to pockets between your teeth and gums where food can get stuck. Smilealign can treat spacing issues.

OVERBITE

An overbite is when your upper teeth overlap your lower front teeth. Most people have an overbite to a degree, but in some cases it can become severe. Correcting severe cases may require a bite opening appliance before you can begin treatment.

OVERJET

Overjet is an alignment condition when the upper teeth protrude outward further than your lower teeth. Sometimes called buck teeth, behaviours in childhood, such as thumb sucking can lead to this alignment issue.

OPEN BITE

If your upper and lower teeth do not come into contact when your mouth is closed, this is known as an open bite. This can lead to difficulties with chewing certain food types. Smilealign can treat mild open bite cases.

FAQs

HOW LONG DOES TREATMENT TAKE?

Treatment duration varies from case to case, depending on how complex it is. The more movement required, the longer the treatment. Your dentist will advise you at your treatment plan consultation, but 6-12 months is a typical timeframe.

HOW MUCH WILL IT COST?

The cost of treatment is dependent on the complexity of your case as prices are based on how many aligners are required to complete your treatment.

ARE THE ALIGNERS UNCOMFORTABLE?

You may experience some tightness when you first put your aligners in, or when you move on to the next aligner in the sequence. Your speech may also be affected during these stages. Both of these are normal and should subside in a day or two.

CAN I EAT AND DRINK WITH MY BRACES IN?

Only drink cold water when wearing your aligners. Hot or sugary drinks cause distortion and impact treatment outcomes. You should not eat whilst wearing your aligners. Remove your aligners when eating or drinking and thoroughly clean them (and your teeth) before replacing.

WHEN DO I CHANGE MY ALIGNER TO THE NEXT ONE?

Each aligner is worn 24 hours a day for a period of two weeks. Your dentist will advise when your teeth have made the required movement from your current brace and issue your next one. There should be no pressure felt on any of the teeth and you should be able to easily remove the aligner before progressing.
